


DID YOU KNOW?

According to the California Energy Commission's 2023 data, over 45% of all California crude oil imports came directly from countries hosting the Amazon Rainforest biome.

REMEMBER,

75% of all crude oil consumed in California is imported. California oil producers now only produce 25% of the state's daily demand.

When California shuts down oil production in California, we become responsible for the destruction of the Amazon Rainforest biome.

South American crude oil is nearly identical to California crude oil—it's heavy oil, which is what California refineries need to mix with light oil coming from the Middle East.

Many people are genuinely concerned about mitigating climate change. The fact is that shutting down production in California is simply being replaced by oil produced by destroying the Amazon Rainforest.
